South Tynedale Railway has transformed the Discovery Centre and it is now home to a contemporary display which tells the story of “The trials and triumphs of a rural railway”. The history of the area; the rise, fall then rise again of the railway, along with the work of the South Tynedale Railway Preservation Society are presented in very accessible information along with a stunning range of photographs and artefacts.

Facilities:
